Harbour can help your children to deal with the affects of witnessing or experiencing abuse in the home through individual or group support.

We understand that many children and young people blame themselves for what has happened and this can lead to emotional or behavioural problems.

We have specialist staff who work with children and young people in a fun and engaging way to give them the support they need. We use activities such as play, art and drama as well as talking through issues. The support is designed around the needs and interests of the children and young people.

We can also work with parents, either alone or together with the child or young person.

What other services do we provide?

We also support adults who have experienced abuse in the home either in the community through our Outreach service or in one of our refuges. We can also offer a service to those who carry out the abuse to enable them to understand and change their behaviour.
